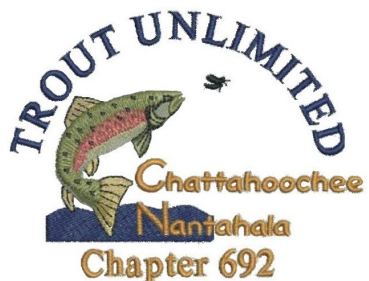

Hello TU 692 members....

Since 2003, our local Chattahoochee/Nantahala Chapter 692 of Trout Unlimited has served the local area by conserving and protecting our precious coldwater fisheries while promoting trout fishing in a sportsmanlike manner. Each year we donate money and volunteer on average 3500 hours performing activities which benefit our fellow citizens. These activities include:

- To create, restore and improve fish habitats in local rivers and streams.
- Assisting the national fish hatchery in Suches with its annual events: *Special Kids Fishing Rodeo (for disabled children and adults)*, *Veterans Appreciation Day* and the *Seniors Fishing Rodeo*
- Paying tuition for 2 worthy teenagers to attend a week-long Trout Camp each summer where they are taught fly fishing, conservation and sportsmanlike angling.
- Contributing money and volunteers to organizations such as the Hiwassee River Watershed Coalition to help stabilize river banks, prevent excessive sedimentation, educate youth and adults on water ecology issues and monitoring the water quality in our watershed.
- Each year we donate to a scholarship at UGA's Warnell School of Forestry and Natural Resources to support an aspiring student and cold water fisheries research.
- We support middle school classes with the Trout in the Classroom program. We provide the equipment, trout fry, volunteers and stream ecology lessons.
- Providing financial support for Save Georgia Hemlocks and the Hemlock Project.

As a qualified Code Section 501(c)(3) Non-Political Tax Exempt Organization, we hold an annual fundraiser during the Fall in order to sustain these activities in the following year.
