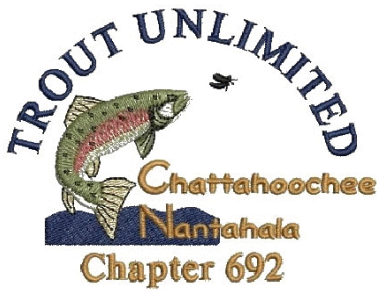

- Assisting the national fish hatchery in Suches with its annual events:

 - *Veterans Appreciation Day*
 - *Family Fishing Festival*

- Working with veterans through *Project Healing Waters and Fly Fishing for Vets* at the local VA Clinic in Blairsville.
- Paying tuition for worthy teenagers to attend a week-long Trout Camp each summer where they are taught fly fishing, conservation and sportsmanlike angling.
- Contributing money to intern programs run by the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, as well as the National Park Service.
- Contributing money to organizations such as the Hiwassee River Watershed Coalition to help stabilize river banks and prevent excessive sedimentation.
